Welcome

Dr. H. B. Suresh, Coordinator, IQAC, welcomed the honourable members of the IQAC and presented the progress attained by the college during the reporting period (July 2021 – September 2021) in a nutshell.

In the beginning the Principal presented the feedback analysis of students, alumnae, teachers and employers. The details of which are shown below:

1. The feedback analysis of students was placed before the Governing Body in its meeting held on 01.09.2021 for approval. Absorbing one feedback, where a hostel student had requested for extending the library working hours beyond the college hours, the Executive Secretary instructed the Principal to extend the working hours of the library from 10.00 am to 6.30 pm, so that students, particularly those staying in hostel, could make the best use of the library.

The members expressed satisfaction over the actions initiated on the recommendations of previous GB Meeting of installing more numbers of aqua purifying units. The principal informed the House that Aqua purifying units had been installed at all the floors students were making best use of it.

2. The feedback analysis of Alumnae was placed before the governing body in its meeting held on 01.03.2021. Noticing a feedback from alumna, working as Assistant Professor of Kannada. The Alumna had suggested including the translations of the poetics of great western critics like Plato, Aristotle and Matthew Arnold so that students of Kannada literature would be acquainted with the criticism of reputed western critics. The director instructed the Principal to speak to the Head of the Department of Kannada to include the poetics of known western critics.

Referring to suggestions made in the previous GB the Principal informed the House that the department of Commerce, as per the directions, had introduced VAP in Tax Management and Banking and

Insurance. The House appreciated the prompt action.

3. The feedback analysis of teachers was placed before the governing body in its meeting held on 01.03.2021. One of the faculties in his feedback had requested to increase the library working hours from 5.pm to 6.30 pm, as it would benefit faculties pursuing Research work. The Executive Secretary instructed the Principal to extend the library working hours.

The Principal informed the House, the action initiated on the direction of the Executive Secretary in the previous Governing Body meeting, that the faculties who wished to borrow more number of reference books were permitted to borrow as many books they wanted for reference. He further informed that many faculties, particularly those who were pursuing Ph.D had been largely benefitted.

4. The feedback analysis of Employers' was placed before the governing body in its meeting held on 01.03.2021. An Employer, in his feedback, had suggested acquainting students with new concepts like Food Biotechnology, which would help students in understanding and teaching new concepts in their specific fields.

Referring to suggestions made in the previous GB the Principal informed the House that the department of Botany, as per the directions, had introduced 'mushroom cultivation technology' in its recent revision of syllabus.

The House appreciated the prompt efforts.

On the recommendation made by Sri. Umesha in the previous meeting of IQAC, the Department of Physical Education, in association with IQAC, organized a 5-Day Yoga camp for the benefit of students. **Mr. Rajashekara Murthy**, International Yoga trainer, based in **China** was the Resource Person. The Inmates of Hostel, numbering nearly 500 and members of faculty received the benefits of Yoga training.

Responding to the suggestion made by Prof. B. P. Indira regarding familiarizing faculty with NEP 2020, the college organized a special Orientation Programme for the benefit of faculty on 07.09.2021 on the topic New Education Policy (NEP) & its consequences. Prof. M P Vijayendra Kumar, faculty dept. of Commerce, JSS College Nanjanagud, was the Resource person.

The Resource Person dwelt in detail on the recommendations of NEP and its special features like multiple entries and multiple exits and special provision like Open Electives for the benefit of students.

The session was very informative as it was followed by useful interaction.

Responding to the suggestion made by Mrs. Brindala Mallappa, the college, in association with District Legal Services Authority (DLSA) organized a special legal awareness and outreach programme for the benefit of students. Mrs. Sudhasethuram, Principal Judge, IV Additional family court, Mysuru was the Chief Guest.

The Principal judge spoke on the Rights of Women particularly in the family matters and enlightened the students about the constitution guaranteed rights and how they could protect themselves against exploitation.

Taking note of the Recommendation made by **Sri. T. N. Prabhakar**, the college had organized Orientation Programme for freshers on 22nd and 23rd September 2021. On the first day students of Science Stream were familiarized with the new rules of NEP by the Principal. On the Second day Students of Commerce and Arts streams were acclimatized with the rules of NEP by the Principal and Dean.

Appreciating the prompt actions initiated by the college on the recommendations made in the previous meetings, Prof. B P Indira suggested celebrating Kannada Rajyothsava meaningfully highlighting the contributions made by erstwhile writers and political leaders in the formation of Karnataka state. She further advised that Department of Kannada should take initiative in organizing Rajyothsava programme on a grand scale.

The members, unanimously, expressed satisfaction over the academic growth of the college and action initiated on the suggestions made in the previous meeting.

Dr. H. B. Suresh, Coordinator, IQAC, welcomed the honourable members of the IQAC and presented the progress attained by the college during the reporting period (Dec 2020 –March 2021) in a nutshell.

In the last meeting of IQAC held on 23.12.2020, Prof. K. S. Lokesh, had enquired about the implementation of NEP 2020 and how the college had prepared itself to face the new situation

Action Taken

The college, taking note of the challenges involved in implementing NEP, constituted a high power committee with principal as its Chairperson and other senior faculties as members of NEP implementation committee. The committee was directed to go through the recommendations / instructions in framing new curricula and to discuss the pros and cons of NEP implementation.

The committee, consisting of Dr. H. B. Suresh, Dr. K. S. Rajashekara, Dr. Rechanna, Dr. Kongalappa, Dr. Lokeshwari and Dr. Saritha, after a thread bare discussion of NEP 2020, recommended the IQAC to constitute new Boards of Studies, as per the new guidelines of UGC.

Accordingly, new Boards were formed and the Chairpersons called the meeting of respective Boards to frame syllabi as per the new guidelines. All the 24 Boards have finalized their syllabi, which would be placed before the next Academic Council for approval. Once the Academic Council approves the draft syllabi the new curricula would come into force.

Noticing the alarming rise in Covid -19 cases, Prof. T. S. Venugopal recommended to arrange vaccination drive, as Govt of India was providing free vaccination facility to all the citizens.

Suggestion Noted

Participating in the discussion on the spread of Covid -19 and people becoming easy prey to the deadly disease, Umesha suggested organizing a special lecture on boosting immunity which could benefit the students.

Observing the prevailing confusion in the implementation of NEP 2020, Prof. B. P. Indira suggested organizing an Orientation Programme for the benefit of faculty so that the teachers would be better informed about the recommendations in NEP 2020.

Commenting on the importance of conserving energy, Prof. Morabada Mallikarjuna recommended organizing special lecture on the topic Energy Conservation, specially by the Department of Geography.

Dr. H. B. Suresh, Coordinator, IQAC, welcomed the honourable members of the IQAC and presented the progress attained by the college during the reporting period (July 2019 –June 2020) in a nutshell.

Observing the progress of the college, Prof. K. S. Lokesh, highlighted the importance of IQAC of the college in maintaining the quality of education being imparted in the college and in maintaining the curriculum and administrative standards of the college. The Professor, further wanted to know the preparedness of the college for implementation of NEP and handling the situation arising out of Corona pandemic.

The Principal, assured that the information sought by the Professor would be placed before the house in the next IQAC meeting.

The members dwelled in detail about the issue of single subject degree, recommended in the previous IQAC meeting, by an Autonomous college. The House was informed that introducing single subject degree could be difficult as brought to the notice of the honourable members in the previous IQAC meeting because the University of Mysore does not have such a programme.

Responding to this Prof. Venugopal, Prof. T. N. Prabhakar and Prof. K. S. Lokesh observed that the matter should not be sidelined but urged upon to push the matter further.

Responding to this Prof. Morabada Mallikarjun informed the House that the college should try to take the University into confidence and convince the authorities of the University, without necessarily entering into conflict, to give approval to introduce single subject degree.

It was resolved to take the matter further forward by writing to the University.

Prof. Venugopal observed that the books added to the library in the academic year was not very encouraging and advised that the college should add more books to the library.

Suggestion noted.

Prof. Mahadevappa expressed satisfaction over action initiated on MOOC and SWAYAM credit transfer, as recommended by him in the previous meeting and suggested that students should be encouraged to learn Artificial Intelligence and undergo Machine Learning. The Professor further advised to have an MoU with NASCOM

Suggestion noted.

Observing the progress of the college Prof. T. N. Prabhakar made following suggestions:

- I. To pursue the matter of single subject degree to its logical end.
- II. To give comparison of results between JSSCW and other good colleges in the city.
- III. To make the best of COVID situation by arranging more number of webinars on relevant issues.
- IV. To institute gold medals in the names of Kitturu Chennamma and Kalpana Chawla to motivate and inspire students.
- V. To keep a copy of translated version of 'Arthashastra' by T.S. Shankar as the book was very informative and would be useful to students.

Prof. B. P. Indira commented that the faculty should be well equipped and encouraged to handle more number of online classes.

Suggestion noted.

Prof. B. P. Indira further wanted to know whether the college had enough resources at its disposal to make all the members of teaching faculty to involve in engaging online classes.

The Principal responded that the IQAC in collaboration with the department of Computer Sciences of the college was successfully handling the situation.

The members, unanimously, expressed satisfaction over the academic growth of the college and action initiated on the suggestions made in the previous meeting.
