#### Welcome

Dr. H. B. Suresh, Coordinator, IQAC, welcomed the honourable members of the IQAC and presented the progress attained by the college during the reporting period (July 2021 – September 2021) in a nutshell.

In the beginning the Principal presented the feedback analysis of students, alumnae, teachers and employers. The details of which are shown below:

1. The feedback analysis of students was placed before the Governing Body, in its meeting held on 01.09.2021 for approval. Absorbing one feedback, where a hostel student had requested for extending the library working hours beyond the college hours, the Executive Secretary instructed the Principal to extend the working hours of the library from 10.00 am to 6.30 pm, so that students, particularly those staying in hostel, could make the best use of the library.

The members expressed satisfaction over the actions initiated on the recommendations of previous GB Meeting of installing more numbers of aqua purifying units. The principal informed the House that Aqua purifying units had been installed at all the floors students were making best use of it.

2. The feedback analysis of Alumnae was placed before the governing body in its meeting held on 01.03.2021. Noticing a feedback from alumna, working as Assistant Professor of Kannada. The Alumna had suggested including the translations of the poetics of great western critics like Plato, Aristotle and Matthew Arnold so that students of Kannada literature would be acquainted with the criticism of reputed western critics. The director instructed the Principal to speak to the Head of the Department of Kannada to include the poetics of known western critics.

Referring to suggestions made in the previous GB the Principal informed the House that the department of Commerce, as per the directions, had introduced VAP in Tax Management and Banking and

Insurance. The House appreciated the prompt action.

3. The feedback analysis of teachers was placed before the governing body in its meeting held on 01.03.2021. One of the faculties in his feedback had requested to increase the library working hours from 5.pm to 6.30 pm, as it would benefit faculties pursuing Research work. The Executive Secretary instructed the Principal to extend the library working hours.

The Principal informed the House, the action initiated on the direction of the Executive Secretary in the previous Governing Body meeting, that the faculties who wished to borrow more number of reference books were permitted to borrow as many books they wanted for reference. He further informed that many faculties, particularly those who were pursuing Ph.D had been largely benefitted.

4. The feedback analysis of Employers' was placed before the governing body in its meeting held on 01.03.2021. An Employer, in his feedback, had suggested acquainting students with new concepts like Food Biotechnology, which would help students in understanding and teaching new concepts in their specific fields.

Referring to suggestions made in the previous GB the Principal informed the House that the department of Botany, as per the directions, had introduced 'mushroom cultivation technology' in its recent revision of syllabus.

The House appreciated the prompt efforts.

On the recommendation made by Sri. Umesha in the previous meeting of IQAC, the Department of Physical Education, in association with IQAC, organized a 5-Day Yoga camp for the benefit of students. Mr. Rajashekara Murthy, International Yoga trainer, based in China was the Resource Person. The Inmates of Hostel, numbering nearly 500 and members of faculty received the benefits of Yoga training.

Responding to the suggestion made by Prof. B. P. Indira regarding familiarizing faculty with NEP 2020, the college organized a special Orientation Programme for the benefit of faculty on 07.09.2021 on the topic New Education Policy (NEP) & its consequences. Prof. M P Vijayendra Kumar, faculty dept. of Commerce, JSS College Nanjanagud, was the Resource person.

The Resource Person dwelt in detail on the recommendations of NEP and its special features like multiple entries and multiple exits and special provision like Open Electives for the benefit of students.

Responding to the suggestion made by Mrs. Brindala Mallappa, the college, in association with District Legal Services Authority (DLSA) organized a special legal awareness and outreach programme for the benefit of students. On the first day students of Science Stream were familiarized with the new rules of NEP by the Principal. On the Second day Students of Commerce and Arts streams were acclimatized with the rules of NEP by the Principal and Dean.

Appreciating the prompt actions initiated by the college on the recommendations made in the previous meetings, Prof. B P Indira suggested celebrating Kannada Rajyothsava meaningfully highlighting the contributions made by erstwhile writers and political leaders in the formation of Karnataka state. She further advised that Department of Kannada should take initiative in organizing Rajyothsava programme on a grand scale.
