Welcome

Dr. K. V. Suresha, Principal, welcomed the honourable members of the IQAC. The Principal made power point presentation, unveiling the progress of the college during the report period.

The Principal presented before the House the feedback analysis of students, Alumnae, Teachers and Employers for approval

The House took note of the feedback and made some observations pertinent to the suggestions as shown below:

1. The feedback analysis of students was placed before the Governing Body in its meeting held on 14.10.2016. The members expressed happiness over the feedback from students. Although there were no negative observations/ opinions, the members suggested further improving the quality of education being disseminated, making education more need based and student – centric
2. The feedback analysis of Alumnae was placed before the governing body in its meeting held on 14/10/16. An Alumna, working in a media house, had suggested including more practical classes for news coverage, editing and give better exposure to work in electronic media. The President of the meeting instructed the principal to prevail upon HoD of Journalism to incorporate the suggested changes in the syllabus
3. The feedback analysis of teachers was placed before the governing body in its meeting held on 14/10/16. Observing one common grievance aired by women faculty about providing Common Room along with attached washroom, Dr. Mruthyunjaya Kulenur, Directed the Principal to provide the requested facility at the earliest.
4. The feedback analysis of Employer's was placed before the governing body in its meeting held on 14/10/16. An employer, a leading Chartered Accountant, had suggested training students in the practical aspects of e-filing so that when students are employed they would find it easy to work in Auditors' Office.

The members of IQAC, after deliberations, appreciated the efforts of the college in following a methodical approach in obtaining feedback analysis from the stake holders and gave approval to same.

Windows based LOGISYS software has been installed in the Examination section to facilitate CBCS examination pattern.


The members, unanimously, expressed satisfaction over the academic growth of the college during the report period and appreciated the achievements of teachers and students in curricular and co-curricular activities.


